Reorganization

The minutes of the previous meeting of December 27th were approved as presented on a motion by Mark, seconded by Jerry and all agreed.

#1 Highway Department

Wil advised that the rental/purchase agreement for a Caterpillar 120H road grader with 900 hours on it from Craigmyle Farm Equipment was acceptable. See below:

Jerry asked about trading in the old grader. Craigmyle's are not interested in trading as it has too many hours on it. The agreement is for rent at \$5,000.00 a month and for the hours used not to exceed 84 hours. An hourly rate of \$60.00/hour will be charged for any hours over the 84. If we decide to purchase it in the first 3 months, 1/2 of the monthly rent will apply to the purchase price of \$88,500.00. Beginning with the 4^{th} month the offer to apply 1/2 of the rent amount to the purchase price will no longer apply.

Mark made a motion to rent-to-own the Caterpillar 120H road grader, seconded by Jerry and all agreed.

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#2 Other Business

<u>2017 Governmental Affairs Service Agreement:</u> Josh explained that Lewis-Kappes, who previously served as our lobbyist for our riverboat revenue, will no longer offer this service. Mark made a motion to approve \$10,000.00 to go the YMCA for the 2017 contract, seconded by Jerry and all agreed.

He asked Jerry if he was willing to be on this board, due to his background, and he agreed. Mark made a motion to appoint Jerry to the EMA board which was seconded by Josh and the motion carried.
