#7 2016 Spay/Neuter Program Funding

Gayle explained that this program is used quit extensively and Bruce wanted to make sure there would be funding for 2016 before he told people to come back in January. Normally this program runs out of funds in October/November. Steve made a motion to approve the \$10,000.00 for the spay/neuter program, seconded by Terry. After some discussion Glenn called for a vote; motion carried.

#8 Planning & Zoning Board Appointments

Josh South had informed council that they need to have representation on the Planning and Zoning Board; this is by statute. A council member and one that they appoint are supposed to be on this board. Josh was not sure as to term length. Mike Bear volunteered to be on this board.

#9 Eric Rabe - Store Support

Mr. Rabe said he was there to answer any questions that may come up. Cody explained that council had agreed to give money for 2014 toward the loan. The county was asked to take the money from taxes and pay \$18,500.00 toward the loan. Cody asked Mr. Rabe if there is still a loan on the "property" where the store is located, Mr. Rabe replied "no". Cody asked when the loan was extinguished; Mr. Rabe thought maybe in 2014. His supplier gave him a low interest loan and he paid off the The initial loan forgiveness agreement was with a original loan. corporation called Subrosa LLC. Mr. Rabe sold Subrosa LLC to another Mr. Rabe is no longer associated with Subrosa LLC. Cody had concerns with regards to working with Economic Development. He would advise council that there is nothing to feasibly salvage from the original agreement because it was with a corporation Mr. Rabe is no longer associated with and the initial loan is also extinguished and the whole basis of the incentive package was a loan forgiveness. Now if council wants to give a grant then that is totally different but as for the purposes of loan forgiveness the circumstances are not feasible.

Jon Bond, of Economic Development, said this program was a small business lending program; not just for the grocery store. The terms for the loan forgiveness program were adopted in July 2012 by county council.

Mr. Rabe felt that since the ownership of the store has not changed he has not breached those terms. Cody does not agree.

Cody said the only way council could help at this point is via a grant or some type of economic incentive for 2015/2016.

Steve and Terry asked Jon Bond to get together with Cody and come up with a plan. Cody asked Jon if it could be done as a grant or some type of incentive; Jon said "yes". There are just certain rules that have to be followed with gaming revenue and grants.

Mike asked why the county is helping to fund a privately owned retail store. Steve said that was the vote back in 2012; to help Mr. Rabe out for 10 years.

Josh South, in the audience, said that at the time of the loan forgiveness vote he was on the Vevay Town Council and voted in favor of the program. The reason he did so was because Mr. Rabe said the building was in such bad shape; Josh would like to know what the money would be spent on now since the building has been repaired/redone and the building has been sold. Mr. Rabe said he has had to replace the roof, the dirt in the front, new side walk, all new frozen cases, all new deli and deli equipment, all new dairy equipment, 2 new compressors, etc. He said he has or will have spent over the 10 year amount. Josh asked, "Going

forward what would the grant or incentive go for". He would use it to help pay his current loan and future bills.

Terry said that Jon and Mr. Rabe need to get together to come up with a plan to go forward. Mr. Rabe asked if council would consider supporting the new plan. Jon said otherwise, if council is not in favor, then coming up with a plan would be a waste of time. The last amount was approximately \$14,000.00.

Jon said council could make a motion asking him to start the process. Terry asked if \$15,000.00 is a good amount to start with. Terry said his opinion would be to have Jon proceed with making a plan, Steve agreed, Mike said he would be against it and Elizabeth said she would not vote for it. Jon is to proceed.

With no further business to come before council, Steve made the motion to adjourn, seconded by Mike and all agreed. The meeting adjourned at 6:14 pm.
