# #4 Other Business

Rachel went to a meeting with the East Enterprise Regional Sewer District and they are going to apply for a grant for \$550,000.00. They are looking at a proposed cost of about \$920,000.00 for repairs and upgrades that are needed for that system. It is a county matching grant. If the total project cost is over \$1,000,000.00, EERSD would be eligible for \$600,000.00 in grant money which would make the county have to come up with \$400,000.00 if it should be decided to do so. This will be discussed at the joint meeting on Monday evening (April 18<sup>th</sup>). IDEM had already sited them numerous times and if IDEM comes in and takes over the consequences will be worse.
