

REGULAR MEETING – MONDAY AT 5:00 P.M.

The Switzerland County Board of Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to law and by being duly advertised.

Those present: commissioners: Josh South, Jerry Monjar, and Jamie Peters, the county attorney, Joe Colussi, the commissioners' assistant, Bruce Williams, and the county auditor, Carolyn Green.

The meeting was called to order by Josh who also led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Jerry made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of September 3, 2019, seconded by Jamie and the motion passed.

Jamie made a motion to approve the claims; seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

#1 Old Business

1. ADA concrete quotes: Josh read the 2 quotes and noted that the JSSCSCC had been removed and the Tech Building parking lot striping was removed.

Fryer Concrete: \$44,050.00 and Deakins Construction: \$47,610.00

Jerry made the motion to approve Fryer Concrete, seconded by Josh and the motion passed. To be paid from casino revenue.

2. Fence gates: This is to make 2 gates in the iron fencing around the courthouse. Madison Iron Works was the only quote received as this is specialty work. Jamie made the motion to approve Madison Iron Works, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed. To be paid from Cum Cap.

3. JSSCSCC inventory: The Town of Vevay would like to have the outside flower pots. Josh read the list of inventory items. Wesley is to go through and keep the maintenance items and the ice maker. The stand-up refrigerator and stove are to go to the Tech Building. The rest would be declared surplus inventory and Pam Acton is to find a home for the rest with non-profit organizations.

4. Snow removal: Bruce is to advertise and then have the bids at the next meeting.

5. Board appointments:

- A. Redevelopment Commission – 3 appointments. Jamie made the motion to reappoint Steve Crabtree, Lary Jones, and Galen Rayles to the board, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

- B. Tourism Board: Tabled until the next meeting.

- C. SIRPC Board: Jamie made the motion to reappoint Sara Brichto to the Board, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

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#2 Highway Department

Darrell reported that chip and seal was completed and that it went well.

Residents on Oatman Hill Road have asked that the road be closed to through traffic. Ohio County is putting up a sign on their end of the road at the request of Ohio County Sheriff Glenn Potts. The sheriff is not allowed to close a road unless it is an emergency situation. This is to try and reroute traffic due to the SR156 closure. The commissioners are not in favor of closing the road.

Red Hog Pike is closed for work.

Fall Cleanup will be October 11, 12, and 13. Jamie made a motion to approve the fall cleanup using 8 dumpsters, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

#3 Miscellaneous

An area of Vevay is being nominated to be placed on the National Register for Historic Places. Joe will look at the paperwork to see what all that nomination entails.

A member of the public asked the commissioners to look into the situation on Seminary Street since the addition of 64 apartments would put too much traffic in that area. He is wanting the building inspector's input. Josh said the zoning board has been contacted but is unsure of whose jurisdiction it would be.

Since there was no further business to come before the board, Jerry made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Jamie and the motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
