

REGULAR MEETING – MONDAY AT 5:00 P.M.

The Switzerland County Board of Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to law and by being duly advertised.

Those present – Commissioners: Grant Dean, Jerry Monjar and Jamie Peters.
County administrator: Susie Swank, auditor: Yvette Emmich, Highway superintendent: Anthony Thomas.

Grant called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes from the regular meeting on July 18, 2022. Minutes were approved with one correction, salt tonnage used last year was 400 tons not 4.5 tons. Jerry made a motion to approve with correction and Jamie seconded.

The claims were approved as presented on a motion by Jamie, seconded by Jerry.

#1 Highway Superintendent – Anthony Thomas

Anthony made the following updates:

- Weed mat down at the dog shelter
- Regular road maintenance
- Installed new bridge signs
- Checking on bus turn-arounds
- Long arming of limbs for buses
- Cleaning and organizing sign room at county garage
- Worked on rood and gutters at county garage
- Evan Hill project is completed
- Request from Brian Craig –Switzerland County Asset Management – Funds are available for this
- Bridge #13, Lower Dugan, is due to be designed in 2023, estimated cost is \$120,500.00 and replacement in 2024, with replacement cost estimated at \$527,500.00.

#2 New Business

a. Rezoning Request – Patriot, IN - On July 20, 2022 Area, Planning and Zoning met and concluded they have no recommendation to re-zone this area. Jamie spoke to the Dollar General Representative and they are no longer interested in placing a store at the Patriot location, at this time. Residents spoke and would like to be notified if the request from Dollar General is presented again in the future.

b. Multi Hazard Mitigation Plan – Tom Moore - Tom presented two proposals for the renewal of our mitigation plan received from Burke Engineering and Polis Center. Jerry made a motion to table this until further clarification on amount of grant and county match.
