The Switzerland County Board of Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to law and by being duly advertised.

Those present: commissioners: Mark Lohide and Jerry Monjar, the county attorney, Wil Goering, and the commissioners' assistant, Bruce Williams. Commissioner Josh South and auditor, Gayle Rayles, were absent.

The meeting was opened by Mark with the pledge of allegiance.

The minutes of the previous meeting of May 21st were approved as presented on a motion by Jerry and seconded by Mark and the motion passed.

#1 Mike Pittman – Sadie Green Road

There was a discussion about a slip on Sadie Green Road. Mr. Pittman has owned property on this road since 1978. He had taken pictures of the road showing the slip.

He has contacts with some of the departments/organizations that might be of help. He works for Hoosier Hills. Mr. Pittman requested permission to set up a meeting to discuss the problem with various departments to which the commissioners agreed.

#2 Laura Helt – Markland Pike Road

Laura said that when there is a heavy rain, water floods her yard and also gets into her basement. Darrell will investigate the problem and see what it would take to make the fix.

There was a discussion about semi-trucks traveling on Markland Pike. The signs are being ignored that prohibit semis on this road.

Jerry will contact the sheriff's office to check on enforcing the ordinance that prohibits semi-trucks from traveling on Markland Pike.

#3 Highway Department

Darrell Keith, highway department supervisor, reported that they are working on Markland Pike and Culbertson roads. He is also obtaining quotes for Scotts Ridge. There was a discussion about hiring GEO Stabilization for work on a wing wall on Allensville Road.

- C. GAI – Road assessment: Mark made a motion to pay GAI for road assessments and to sign the contract which was seconded by Jerry. Rosemary asked the cost of the contract: \$19200.00.
- D. New fund ordinance(#9121): This was tabled for further information until the next meeting.
- E. Tech building website: Sarah Brichto requested the commissioners' signature to ok a website for the tech building to connect to the county website. Mark make the motion to approve the request and was seconded by Jerry and the motion carried.
- F. Meeting at Seymour: Mark mentioned a meeting at Seymour that Carla Armstrong, highway clerk, and Darrell Keith are going to attend.
- G. Dust control & speed limit: Ben Girod of 663 Brushy Fork Road requested some type of dust control. The dust is affecting the children's health. The commissioners advised him that if he purchased the product to control the dust the county would spray it on the road. There was also discussion about reducing the speed limit on Brushy Fork Road.
