

REGULAR MEETING – MONDAY AT 5:00 P.M.

The Switzerland County Board of Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to law and by being duly advertised.

Those present: commissioners: Jerry Monjar and Jamie Peters, the commissioners' assistant, Bruce Williams, and the auditor, Carolyn Green. Commissioner Josh South and county attorney, Wil Goering, were absent.

The meeting was called to order by Jerry who also led the pledge of allegiance.

The minutes of the previous meeting of February 19th were approved as presented on a motion by Jamie, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

Jamie made the motion to approve the claims as presented; seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

#1 Keith Smith – Town of Vevay – JSSCSCC

Keith Smith, speaking for the Town of Vevay, expressed their interest in the JSSCSCC. He stated that the Town of Vevay and the town police had outgrown the Town Hall. He stated that their proposal would not include any provision for senior use of the building. The Town of Vevay would also like to find a good use for their existing location. Several citizens spoke in favor of keeping the building for the use of seniors.

#2 Old Business

MBSD mowing bids: Two bids have been received for the Moorefield Bennington Sewer District mowing:

2. Grassman Unlimited

Jamie made the motion to approve the bid of Grassman Unlimited; seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

Spring Cleanup – April 27th, 27th, 28th: Jerry made the motion to approve the Spring Cleanup dates of April 26, 27, and 28; seconded by Jamie and the motion passed.

JSSCSCC Proposal: The Commissioners want all proposals for the Jack Sullivan Building by the end of the month.

Highway 101: Kenny Riley spoke about the on-going negotiations for Hwy 101.

USI Consultants: Derek Towles, with USI Consultants, presented their qualifications for bridge and highway repair work. He stated that most bridges in the U.S. need to be replaced every 40 years. He stated an Asset Management Plan would cost less than a \$1,000.00.

The commissioners would need feedback from the Council so they wanted this to be placed on the agenda for the next meeting.
