

REGULAR MEETING – MONDAY AT 5:00 P.M.

The Switzerland County Board of Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to law and by being duly advertised.

Those present: commissioners: Josh South, Jerry Monjar, and Jamie Peters, the county attorney, Wil Goering, the commissioners' assistant, Bruce Williams, and the county auditor, Carolyn Green.

The meeting was called to order by Josh who also led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of May 6, 2019 were approved with the following correction of removing the line "They would like to receive more bids hopefully from other local contractors." on a motion by Jamie, seconded by Jerry and all agreed.

The claims were approved as presented on a motion by Jerry, seconded by Jamie and all agreed.

#1 John Moton – Senator Braun's Office

John Moton, Regional Director for the office of U. S. Senator Braun in Indianapolis, introduced himself to the commissioners. He said he can be reached at 317-822-8240.

#2 John Kniola – Bryant's Creek

John Kniola appeared to comment on the dumpster at Bryant's Creek. He stated that there was a need for it by hunters and boaters, but trash is often on the ground.

#3 Highway Department

Darrell Keith presented the quotes by Rohe and McAllister for Bridges 16, 17, and 18. This was with no written guarantee. Jamie made the motion to accept the bid by McAllister for all three. The bids are:

Bridge 18 -- \$30,680.00

Bridge 17 -- \$48,585.40

Bridge 16 -- \$30,680.00

Jerry seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

Darrell will update the chart. North Branch road is finished, Adkinson Hill has been repaired, the mowers are out, and approximately the same number of chip and seals as last year (\$250,000.00), asphalt quotes for Jackson Road and Pendleton Run, also measurements on Log Lick for chip and seal. #4 Old Business

A. Rezoning SR 56: Jerry made the motion to approve the rezoning on S.R. 56 to agricultural. Jaime seconded. Josh abstained due to a conflict of interest. The motion passed.

#5 New Business

1. County business license: A letter stating that the county does not issue business licenses was signed by the commissioners.
2. Broadband ordinance: A motion to approve the Broadband Ordinance was made by Jaime and seconded by Jerry; the motion passed. A motion to appoint Sarah Brichto as the point of contact for the Broadband Ordinance was made by Jaime and seconded by Jerry; the motion passed.
3. Grass ordinance: A motion to approve the ordinance prohibiting grass cuttings, leaves, etc. being left on the highway (a Class C infraction) was made by Jerry and seconded by Jaimie; the motion passed. The ordinance will be published for 30 days, and the sheriff is to be notified.
4. Tourism board appointment: Since there were no applicants for the tourism board, the notice will be republished.
5. Tech building leak: The tech building air conditioner leak has been repaired and charged.
6. JSSCSCC: The offer was made to the Town of Vevay regarding the Jack Sullivan Center. They will make a decision at their upcoming meeting.

With no further business to come before the board, Jaimie made the motion to adjourn, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 5:26 p.m.
