The Switzerland County Board of Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to law and by being duly advertised.

Those present: commissioners: Josh South, Jerry Monjar, and Jamie Peters, the county attorney, Joe Colussi, and county auditor, Carolyn Green.

The meeting was called to order by Jamie who also led the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of April 6<sup>th</sup> and the special meeting minutes of April 16<sup>th</sup> as presented was made by Josh, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

A motion to approve the claims as presented was made by Josh, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

**#1 Final Reading of the Infrastructure Development Ordinance**

Jamie made the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final presentation of the ordinance. A motion to approve the ordinance was made by Josh, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

**#2 Old Business**

Quotes for Dr. Findley's floors: The following 2 quotes for striping and waxing of Dr. Findley's floors were read:

Josh made a motion to table this decision for one month due to the need to curb spending at this time, seconded by Jerry seconded and the motion passed.

Carroll Turner Road: Jerry made a motion to table the decision of whether to resume maintaining Carroll Turner Road until he can get with highway superintendent Darrell Keith, seconded by Jamie and the motion passed 2-1 with Josh opposing.

**#3 New Business**

Employee medical insurance: There was discussion concerning medical insurance for employees who are laid-off due to the current situation. A motion to pay the county's portion if the employee pays their portion was made by Josh, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.

Covid-19 discussion: Josh addressed the public encouraging them to pay their taxes on time. He also encouraged voluntary layoffs of county employees. He encouraged the county council to decide soon with their recommendations to offset the loss of casino revenue. Josh stated that by statute elected officials' salaries cannot be changed until a new budget year.
