A motion to approve the claims as presented was made by Josh, seconded by Jerry for discussion. There was a question about 1 of the claims which after the explanation the motion passed.

#1 Old Business

1. Carroll Turner Road: Since the repairs to the road may be cost prohibitive, it may be necessary to amend the existing ordinance to adopt a road. The attorney will review the existing ordinance and get back with his opinion. This was tabled until a later meeting.

#2 New Business

- A. Opening County offices: One option is to leave things as they are until the May 18th meeting. Wesley Poling is to get quotes on protective barriers for the county offices. Josh recused himself since his company is in this business. A motion to keep things as they are for the next two weeks was made by Josh, seconded by Jerry and the motion carried.
- B. WTH: Electronic Map Data Application from CoreLogic requesting County GIS Data: A motion to approve the CoreLogic request for the amount of \$750.00 was made by Josh, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed.
