

**REGULAR MEETING – MONDAY AT 5:00 P.M.**

The Switzerland County Board of Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to law and by being duly advertised.

Those present: commissioners: Josh South, Jerry Monjar, and Jamie Peters, the county attorney, Joe Colussi, and the county auditor, Carolyn Green.

The meeting was called to order by Jamie with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Jerry made the motion to approve the minutes, as presented, of the regular meeting of May 18<sup>th</sup>, seconded by Josh and the motion passed.

A motion to approve the claims as presented was made by Jerry, seconded by Josh and the motion passed.

**#1 Steve Starkey – Sportsman’s Club Noise**

A noise complaint was lodged against the gun club for excessive noise after dark. The complaint was not against the club itself just the shooting after dark. Mr. Starkey was asked to contact the Zoning Board and the Club Board to see if they could work out something.

**#2 Cliff & Regina Shanks – County Owned Property on SR156**

Regina Shanks asked about the property located at Ash and SR 156. She believed it was county property.

**#3 Sarah Brichto & John Sieglitz – Public Wifi Locations**

Sarah said more information is needed on the status of the public wifi locations and county liability.

**#4 New Business**

- A. Cybersecurity: Jerry made a motion to table the topic of Fireeye cyber security, seconded by Josh and the motion passed.
- B. YMCA contract: The contract was signed per the agreement in January.

**#5 Old Business**

- 1) Shelter lights: The cost to repair the lights caused by water spray can be taken from the donations previously designated for part-time help; the Dangle Fund.
- 2) Belterra reopening: Josh expressed concern over the timing of the re-start of Belterra. Since Belterra could lay-off more than 25% of their employees, it is probably not time to bring back our laid off personnel.
- 3) Carroll Turner Road: Josh believes that if Jerry wants an amendment to the ordinance he needs to work on getting that done. Joe will work on this.

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With no further business to come before the board, Josh made the motion to adjourn, seconded by Jerry and the motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 5:40 p.m.
