


- a **Patty Jackson**: Housing grant for Switzerland county. Owner occupied rehab programs for Switzerland county. There are approximately 35 families on the waiting list. Grant will be applied for and Switz will be named as the beneficiary of the fund. Money could be anywhere from \$100,000.00 to \$300,000. They will be asking for \$350,000.00 which could help up to 15 families. If OCRA grant announces anything for next year they may hold on to money until next year to combine all monies. Recipient will need to own home, insurance will need to be paid up and property taxes. Cannot do land contracts, property in the flood plain and single wide.
- b. **John Kniola**: Park news-will be attending the Patriot town hall meeting. Town of Vevay continues to do nothing after written complaints. April 19<sup>th</sup> Warsaw paper reports the county attorney is rewriting the guidelines to make it easier to prosecute people that don't take care of their properties and that should be done by mid-May.
