The Switzerland County Council met in special session pursuant to law and by being duly advertised.


Those present: Todd Chase, Mat Dutkiewicz, Lisa Fisher, Andy Haskell and Randy Leap, county auditor, Gayle Sullivan, HR director LeeAnne Howe. Lance Collier, Todd Chase and Mike Bear were not present.


Randy Leap called the meeting to order and turned over to Grant Dean. Grant spoke about changes to wages for SCER. Wage increase would hopefully help bring in and help retain employees. Grant is asking for a change for basic EMT from \$15.72 to \$18.00, advanced EMT would go \$17.49 to \$20.50 and paramedic would go \$18.36-\$24.00. This wage increase would put us in a more complete state. At the end of June, the commissioners will look at the budget for SCER and see where they are at as far as what monies may be needed to finish out the year. Lisa made a motion to increase salaries for basic and advance EMT and paramedics, starting on June 5<sup>th</sup>'s payroll. Andy made a second and all in favor.


